9 Petition for pedestrian bridge over the brook on the A515

The Parish council and a number of residents had met Cllr Simon Spencer at the bridge. He was not hopeful of a quick solution due to money and priorities.

A number of proposals were discussed for making the bridge safer but it is the County Council’s responsibility to make the bridge safe for pedestrians and as they believe there have been no accidents they do not believe it is a priority.

Cllr Simon Spencer did suggest we raise a petition as the County Council have a policy of investigating and responding to petitions. It was resolved that we would define some words of what we want and start collecting signatures.
